We are proud to announce the launch of a unique professional development opportunity — a **UMN-UP Professional Learning Community (PLC)**. We are looking for enthusiastic colleagues who would like to connect with University of Minnesota as well as across UP, grow their professional network, step out of their own bubble, and improve teaching and learning practices by actively seeking global input to make a local impact at UP.

What is UMN-UP PLC?

- On-line interdisciplinary COMMUNITY of ACADEMICS who exchange their expertise and develop teaching competences, work together on joint design and delivery of curricular projects of their choice.
- IT IS NOT TRAINING, but a facilitated space of collegial exchange, with shared ownership and individual commitment.
- Regular monthly on-line meetings (90 mins) for the duration 1 year, Sept 2022—May 2023

For whom:

- Open to academics and PhD candidates from any discipline who want:
 - o to improve teaching of our students and get new tools and tips,
 - o to share in intercultural collegial space and to exchange knowledge with UMN colleagues,
 - o to advance your international academic career through intensive experiences.
- You can join in an existing partnership with colleague at UMN or alone (you can reach out to us, and we can try to find you a matching discipline UMN colleague).

Currently, we are looking for 15–20 colleagues across UP who would like to commit to our community with 90 mins monthly on-line meetings over one academic year 2022/2023.

What you learn?

- PARTICIPANTS' CHOICE participants decide what are their needs and goals to learn, perhaps:
 - o how to (co-)design internationalized modules/courses/short-term study visits, or
 - o how to improve your (co-)teaching and facilitation of international classrooms, or
 - o how to do COIL together, etc.
